Thought for the Week

We celebrate the Second Sunday of Advent this weekend, whilst the media and the world around already seem to be throwing themselves into Christmas celebrations with carols, mince pies and turkeys. Advent, however, is a time of reflecting and preparing – not just for Christ's coming at Christmas but his second coming in glory at the end of time.

This week's Gospel reading reflects on John the Baptist, preparing the way for Jesus, "proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins". And in our Second Reading, St Paul tells the Philippians that he is praying that their "love may abound more and more," so that they may "be pure and blameless for the day of Christ".

As those who are baptised, we are on the journey through life towards that final day of Christ. We are called to live our lives always looking towards that time, turning back when we go astray and growing more and more in love of God and of others. To help us especially in this, we have the sacrament of Reconciliation, and we have two Penitential Services in our Parish of Christ the King this Advent – Saturday 14 December at 11:00 at St Edward's, Windsor and Wednesday 18 December at 19:00 at St Francis of Assisi, Ascot. All are welcome.

This Advent, may we all journey forward in faith and love towards that glorious day of our Lord Jesus Christ.
