

Feast of Christ The King – 24 November 2024

Thought for the week

The church's year ends with the Solemnity of Christ The King; a reminder that at the end of time, Christ, the Universal king, will be recognised as ruler of all nations. The hymn - 'The day thou gavest Lord, has ended' speaks of Christ in the lines: 'Thy throne shall never, like earth's proud empire, pass away; thy kingdom stands, and grows for ever;' 'empires' in all their manifestations have come, gone and will go but we believe that Christ will conquer all.

It is fitting that the year which begins in Advent, when we look forward to the second coming of the Messiah and our celebration of His first coming as a vulnerable child in Bethlehem, ends with the proclamation of His universal sovereignty. In his dialogue with Pilate in this weekend's Gospel, a narrative which we also hear on Good Friday before he dies on the cross for our salvation, Jesus is asked by the Roman governor 'so you are a king' and Jesus replies 'For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world - to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice.'

This Solemnity will now be the patronal feast of our new parish of 'Christ The King, Windsor- Ascot'. This year is the beginning of a new phase in the life of our local Catholic community with three churches whose patrons, each in their own way, recognised Christ as their Lord and King. With the help of their prayers, let us build on the strong foundations of St Edward's, St Francis and St Mark's, who have witnessed to the truth for generations and together find new ways to listen to Christ's voice and proclaim His truth in prayer, word and action.

This week Canon David received the decree from the Bishop creating our new parish of Christ The King:

I, the undersigned Bishop of Portsmouth, exercising my ordinary power and in virtue of canon 515 §2, do hereby decree that the Parish of St Edward's, Windsor, with all the rights, obligations, and privileges accorded it by law, be and is hereto united to and amalgamated with the Parish of St Francis of Assisi, Ascot. I herewith decree that on account of this extinctive-union and amalgamation of the Parish of St Edward's with the Parish of St Francis Assisi, is hereto re-named and is henceforth legally to be known as Christ The King, Windsor-Ascot, with all the rights, obligations, and privileges granted it by law.

New translation of the lectionary

What is happening and why?

The Lectionary, which is the book that contains the Scripture readings for Mass and the Sacraments, is changing as part of the continuing process of revising liturgical translations. The process began with the Roman Missal in 2011 and has continued with all the other liturgical texts.

What translation will the new Lectionary use?

The new Lectionary will use both the English Standard Version - Catholic Edition of the Bible and the Abbey Psalter for the psalms.

What effect will the changes have on the readings?

The changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, to reflect current biblical scholarship, and to provide a text for use in liturgical setting that is easier to proclaim and, where appropriate, more inclusive.

When are the changes taking place?

The lectionary will become mandatory for use in all Catholic parishes and Mass centres in England and Wales, and in Scotland from Advent 2024 (1st December).
