# Thought for the Week

I rejoice that this weekend the Bishop will ordain Stephen Patterson as a Deacon for the communities of Windsor and Ascot. He will join the ranks of many fellow Deacons in the diocese among whom of course is Deacon George who was ordained Deacon for the parish of Windsor Twenty-Two years ago. Both Deacon George and Stephen will minister to the combined parishes of Ascot and Windsor. They will become familiar faces in both communities. But the ministry of Deacon, is far more than just being seen vested at Mass on a Sunday. Deacons are ministers of the Word, the Altar, and of Charity. As we know from the Acts of the Apostles - the early apostles were overwhelmed at the amount of work and were neglecting some of their duties - so they selected others to assist, these they called Deacons, and they would have a particular care for the needs of others.

So what can deacons do? They are to bring God's Word to believer and unbeliever alike, to preside over public prayer, to baptise, to assist marriages and bless them, to give viaticum to the dying to lead the rights of burial.

In the pontifical for the Rite of Ordination of a Deacon it says: once he is consecrated by the laying on his hands that comes to us from the apostles and is bound more closely to the altar, he will perform works of charity in the name of the Bishop or Pastor. From the way he goes about these duties, may you recognise him as a disciple of Jesus who came to serve, not to be served.

Stephen, I know that you have the respect and support of the community, and you will receive a warm welcome from Deacon George to work alongside him, as well as assisting with Fr Phillip and I the Altar of Sacrifice and Charity.


