Thought for the Week

We start this great month with the Feast of All Saints on 1 November and then during the course of the month we are invited to remember all those great Holy Souls who have departed this life - who tried as best they could to live a life worthy of the calling so that they might inherit God's Kingdom and become Saints.

Saints all have in common a kind of wholeheartedness that the books of Deuteronomy and the Gospel of Mark speak of - that we hear of this Sunday. To love the Lord our God with all one's heart and one's neighbour as oneself.

The wisdom shared by all the Saints, was not about the particular talents they brought to the world, it was about the wholeheartedness of love, a willingness to give it away. They also seem to know that wholeheartedness was not a matter of 'Once and for all', or something that would happen overnight. It was, rather, a matter of opening up their entire lives to the transforming grace of God.

I would suggest the watchword for this Sunday's Liturgy could be **priority** – what do we consider as the importance in our Christian calling? Do we need possibly to slightly tweak our priorities so that we can ensure that our love of God is alongside and within our love of neighbour.

During the cold winter nights before the Pandemic, a Night Shelter was offered to the homeless people of Windsor under the name 'More Than a Shelter' in the Parish Centre. The guests were offered a warm meal, a warm bed for the night, and breakfast. The charity has merged with WCA and is now part of the Windsor Homeless Project. Last week, planning permission was granted to run a Night Shelter at the Homeless Project home, Alma Beacon.

To run the shelter, we need volunteers to cover 84 shifts per week:

- Evening Meal 07:00pm - 10:00pm
- Overnight 10:00pm - 07:00am
- Breakfast 07:00am - 08.30am
