Thought for the Week

Today's Gospel passage follows on from the miracle of the feeding of the five thousand. Whilst the people's physical hunger had been satiated, they were still looking for "signs," being unable to recognise in their minds and hearts the miracle that had been worked and therefore unable to recognise who Jesus is. Jesus reminds them that, as we heard in our First Reading today, it was God who gave his people the Manna in the desert – the bread from heaven that sustained them on their journey to the promised land. In the same way, he gives his people, then and now, "the true bread... which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." That bread is the bread of life – Jesus himself.

When we open ourselves to receiving Jesus in our lives, something amazing happens. As Jesus says, "He who comes to me will never be hungry; he who believes in me will never thirst." He is talking here not so much of transient physical hunger and thirst but of the deep spiritual need we have as human beings to be close to God. Jesus is Immanuel, God-with-us: he came among us to enable us to come close once more to his Father.

At every Mass, Jesus continues to give himself for us as the perfect sacrifice and the bread of heaven who brings us eternal life: let us always recognise him as our Lord and Saviour, the One our world so urgently needs. Let us worship him and receive him with renewed faith, so that we can proclaim him ever more effectively in the world today.
