Epiphany of the Lord – 5 January 2025

Thought for the Week

This weekend we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord; the readings are rich in opulent imagery. There are camels, kings, gold, frankincense and myrrh, it is all very poetic and atmospheric. The imagery stresses that Jesus came not just for the shepherds of Bethlehem or the townsfolk of Nazareth; he came for all peoples. The psalm says: 'all places will serve him' and Isaiah wrote 'nations shall come to your light,' it is neatly summarised by St Paul who observes that '... the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus.'

We know nothing more about the Magi, we do not know how many wise men from the east there were who returned to their own country bypassing Jerusalem to avoid a second meeting with Herod. Like a caravan of camels passing through the desert they disappear from scripture. However, they do not disappear before they have fallen down and worshipped the child. Whether they truly understood the divine nature of Jesus is immaterial, it was travellers from an antique land who first recognised and honoured the infant king of the Jews: a phrase we will not hear again until the adult Jesus next meets a powerful Gentile; Pilate.

The Magi were guided by a star. As a New Year opens, can we be a star guiding others to the house where Christ and his family rest or, like the Magi, take a risk to seek him out. Or are we like Herod only saying that we will worship him when we have more information? The camels' footprints have long disappeared in the desert, but the impact of the curious, adventurous explorers who rode them opened the world to Christ and changed it for ever, who are we helping to lead to Jesus?

The Jubilee Year is upon us, and we began with Pope Francis opening the Holy Door in St Peter's in Rome on Christmas Eve. In the parish, we started the Holy Year with a Holy Hour of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at 15:00, this will continue on **Sunday 26 January 2025 in Ascot.**

This will be a special year of forgiveness and reconciliation, in which people are invited to return to a right relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation. This Jubilee Year is a great opportunity to bring together and foster a sense of unity among the diverse cultures and communities that make up our vibrant Church family.
