THE SECOND SUNDAY OF **ORDINARY TIME**

FOLLOWING OUR CELEBRATION OF ADVENT, CHRISTMAS AND THE EPIPHANY - WE NOW ENTER - UNTIL THE BEGINNING OF LENT, THE PERIOD KNOWN AS 'ORDINARY TIME'. AND THERE COULD BE NO BETTER SUBJECT TO REFLECT UPON AS THIS NEW YEAR BEGINS, THAN THAT OF 'BEING CHOSEN' FOR SOMETHING UNIQUE AND LIFE CHANGING. IF WE SAY TO OURSELVES, 'WELL, I'VE NEVER BEEN CHOSEN FOR ANYTHING SPECIAL IN MY LIFE' - WELL THINK AGAIN! OUR BAPTISM MADE US UNIQUE AND SPECIAL PEOPLE: IF WE'RE MARRIED, THEN WE ARE CHOSEN TO BE SPECIAL PEOPLE - AND SO, ALL OF US CAN REFLECT FOR A MOMENT ON THE MANY OPPORTUNITIES THAT HAVE BEEN GIVEN TO US ALL. AND IF WE'RE STILL NOT CONVINCED - BEAR IN MIND THAT BEING LOVED BY GOD AND SAVED THROUGH CHRIST MAKES EACH ONE OF US SOMEONE VERY SPECIAL INDEED!

- * THE OPENING PRAYER ASKS GOD OUR FATHER TO HEAR US: " ... AND BESTOW YOUR PEACE ON OUR TIMES ... "
- * OUR OLD TESTAMENT READING IS FROM THE FIRST BOOK OF SAMUEL. WE HEAR HOW THE GREAT LEADER IS CALLED BY THE LORD AS HE SLEEPS ... FI-NALLY WHEN SAMUEL REALISES THAT THE LORD IS SPEAKING TO HIM, HE RE-SPONDS BY SAYING: " ... SPEAK, LORD, YOUR SERVANT IS LISTENING ... SAM-UEL GREW UP AND THE LORD WAS WITH HIM AND LET NO WORD OF HIS FALL TO THE GROUND ... ".
- * The second reading is from St Paul's first letter to the Corinthians. THE APOSTLE CELEBRATES THAT CHRISTIAN PEOPLE FORM PART OF THE BODY OF CHRIST: " ... YOUR BODIES ARE MEMBERS MAKING UP THE BODY OF CHRIST; ANYONE WHO IS JOINED TO THE LORD IS ONE SPIRIT WITH HIM ..."
- * OUR GOSPEL READING IS ST JOHN'S ACCOUNT OF HOW ST ANDREW, WHO WAS A DISCIPLE OF JOHN THE BAPTIST, FINDS JESUS AND THEN INVITES HIS BROTH-ER SIMON PETER TO COME AND MEET JESUS AS WELL: "... ANDREW MET HIS BROTHER AND SAID TO HIM 'WE HAVE FOUND THE MESSIAH ... AND HE TOOK SIMON TO JESUS ... "
