THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

This is 'Gaudete Sunday' — Latin for 'Rejoicing Sunday' — AND WHAT ARE WE REJOICING ABOUT? — THAT THE LORD IS VERY CLOSE! BUT WHAT DOES THAT MEAN? AS THE LATE POPE EMERITUS BENEDICT XVI SAID "THAT CLOSENESS IS NOT A QUESTION OF SPACE AND TIME BUT RATHER A CLOSENESS OF LOVE: LOVE BRINGS PEOPLE TOGETHER ...". WE WILL SEE THE CLOSENESS OF GOD WHEN WE GAZE INTO THE CRIB AT CHRISTMAS. THE CRIB MAKES A STATEMENT THAT OUR GOD HAS CHOSEN, OUT OF TOTAL LOVE FOR EACH ONE OF US, TO ENTER THIS WORLD AND TO SHARE OUR HUMANITY AND GAIN FOR US FREEDOM FROM SIN AND DEATH. CHRISTIAN JOY IS BUILT ON OUR AWARENESS OF HOW MUCH WE ARE LOVED! PERHAPS WE CAN REFLECT FOR A MOMENT ON THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THESE WORDS, WHICH WE SING IN THE CAROL 'HARK THE HERALD ANGELS SING' ... "VEILED IN FLESH THE GODHEAD SEE, HAIL THE INCARNATE DEITY ... PLEASED AS MAN WITH MAN TO DWELL, JESUS OUR EMMANUAL" ... EMMANUAL GOD WITH US — GOD CLOSE TO US! FOR ALL THIS WE REJOICE TODAY!

- * As we await the Lord's coming, our Opening Prayer asks God our Father to enable us to: "... Attain the Joys of so great a salvation ..."
- * THE FIRST READING IS FROM THE PROPHET ISAIAH. THE PROPHET GIVES THANKS THAT THE COMING OF THE MESSIAH WILL: "... MAKE INTEGRITY AND PRAISE SPRING UP IN THE SIGHT OF THE NATIONS ...".
- * Our second reading is from the first letter of St Paul to the Thessalonians. The Apostle tells his Christian readers to: "... be happy at all times; pray constantly; and for all things give thanks to God, because this is what God expects you to do in Christ Jesus..."
- * THIS GOSPEL READING THIS WEEK IS FROM ST JOHN. THE EVANGELIST TELLS US MORE ABOUT THE WITNESS OF ST JOHN THE BAPTIST: "... I BAPTISE WITH WATER, BUT THERE STANDS AMONG YOU ... THE ONE WHO IS COMING AFTER ME AND I AM NOT FIT TO UNDO HIS SANDAL-STRAP ..."
