Fr Phillip writes...

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

This Sunday is Good Shepherd Sunday. Jesus proclaims to the people - and us - that "I am the good shepherd..."

The beautiful image of a shepherd calling and leading his flock comes from the Middle-Eastern practice of a shepherd going ahead of his flock rather than herding them from behind as we are used to in Europe. He leads them, singing or whistling or playing a pipe, and they follow because they know his voice and they trust him, since he is leading them to fresh pasture.

Christ is our Good Shepherd – he calls each one of us. More than this, he is "the good shepherd... who lays down his life for his sheep." From the day of our conception we are unique individual human beings, called into life by the Lord, and called to follow him in life. By his saving death on the Cross, he has saved us from the

ravages of sin - the wolf that would scatter us - and opened the path to heaven and eternal life for us.

The sheep when they follow their shepherd trust him: we trust our Good Shepherd. When he calls us in the silence of our hearts, we should follow. What are you being called to now in your life? How will you respond?
