Kevin writes...

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

On this Saturday evening and Sunday morning, we are still in Advent - just! Our Christmas celebrations begin later this evening! ... but were it not for the woman we think about in the Masses of Advent 4 ... there would be no Christmas to celebrate! Our thoughts turn to the woman named 'Miriam' in Hebrew; 'Maria' in Latin; and to us English speakers - 'Mary'. Our Gospel reading is the account of the Annunciation - that moment when Mary said 'Yes' to God and so made our salvation possible! The late Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI says of the Annunciation: "God knocked at Mary's heart and, having received her 'yes', began to take flesh, in her and from her". The great English poet William Wordsworth (a Protestant) ... began to understand the truth of the Catholic Faith when, at the beginning of the 19th century, he penned these words in his sonnet 'The Virgin':

> 'Woman! Above all women glorified. Our tainted nature's solitary boast: Purer than foam on central ocean tost: Brighter than eastern skies at daybreak strewn ...'

- * Our Opening Prayer are words from the 'Angelus' which is said three times daily in every religious community throughout the Catholic world: "... Pour forth ... O Lord, your grace into our hearts, that we, to whom the Incarnation of Christ your Son was made known by the message of an Angel, may by his Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of his Resurrection ..."
- *The first reading is from the second book of Samuel. The prophet Nathan tells King David of Israel that the Lord will preserve his offspring for ever. For Christian, this is a reference to the coming of Christ: "...I will be a father to him and he a son to me... your throne will be established for ever ...".
- * Our second reading is from the letter of St Paul to the Romans. The Apostle speaks of the wonder of the coming of Christ into the world as a: "...mystery kept secret for endless ages, but now so clear that it must be broadcast to pagans everywhere ..."
- * The Gospel reading this week proclaims Mary's 'Yes' to God: "... 'I am the handmaid of the Lord,' said Mary, 'let what you have said be done to me' ... "





