# THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

THE JOY OF CHRISTMAS MOST CERTAINLY CONTINUES THIS WEEK WITH THE CELE-BRATION OF THE LORD'S EPIPHANY ... THE WORD 'EPIPHANY' IS A GREEK WORD THAT MEANS 'THE SHOWING FORTH OR THE REVEALING OF A GOD'. FOR MANY PEOPLE THE CELEBRATION OF CHRISTMAS COMES TO A JUDDERING HALT WITH 'Twelfth-night' - it's down with the decorations - it's all back to work; BACK TO SCHOOL; BACK TO THE USUAL ROUTINE ... HOWEVER ... FOR US AS CATHOLIC CHRISTIANS THE WONDER OF CHRISTMAS ENDURES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR! FOR EXAMPLE, EVERY MASS IS A CELEBRATION OF CHRISTMAS - AS CHRIST COMES TO OUR ALTARS WITH THAT SAME BODY AND BLOOD, WHICH HE WORE INCARNATE FROM THE WOMB OF OUR LADY. THROUGHOUT THIS NEW YEAR, ALL THE SACRAMENTS WE CELEBRATE, WILL BE SIGNS THAT THE RISEN CHRIST IS SHOWERING US WITH HIS GRACE. IN SO MANY WAYS THE LORD SHOWS FORTH HIS DIVINE NATURE - AND MOST OF ALL - IN EVERY ONE OF US, AS WE STRIVE TO BECOME MORE CHRISTLIKE AND THEREBY, ATTRACT OTHER TO THE LORD.

- \* OUR OPENING PRAYER ASKS GOD OUR FATHER TO BRING US: " ... WHO KNOW YOU ALREADY BY FAITH ... TO BEHOLD THE BEAUTY OF YOUR SUBLIME GLORY
- \* THE FIRST READING IS FROM THE OLD TESTAMENT PROPHET ISAIAH. THE PROPHET LOOKS TO THAT FUTURE TIME WHEN THE MESSIAH WILL APPEAR IN GLORY. FOR US TODAY, THIS IS A PROPHECY CONCERNING THE COMING OF JESUS CHRIST: "... ARISE, SHINE OUT JERUSALEM, FOR YOU LIGHT HAS COME ... LIFT UP YOUR EYES AND LOOK AROUND ALL ARE ASSEMBLING AND COMING TOWARDS YOU ... ".
- Our second reading is from the letter of St Paul to the Philippians. THE APOSTLE CELEBRATES THAT CHRIST'S MESSAGE IS NOT JUST FOR A CHO-SEN FEW BUT FOR ALL HUMANITY: " ... IT MEANS THAT PAGANS NOW SHARE THE SAME INHERITANCE, THAT THEY ARE PART OF THE SAME BODY, AND THAT THE SAME PROMISE HAS BEEN TO THEM, IN CHRIST JESUS, THROUGH THE GOS-PEL" ...
- \* THE GOSPEL READING IS ST MATTHEW'S ACCOUNT OF THE COMING OF THE WISE MEN TO WORSHIP THE INFANT CHRIST: " ... OPENING THEIR TREASURES, THEY OFFERED HIM GIFTS OF GOLD AND FRANKINCENSE AND MYRRH ...

MESSAGE FROM HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS FOR THE 57TH **WORLD DAY OF PEACE** 1 JANUARY 2024 ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND PEACE

AT THE BEGINNING OF THE NEW YEAR, A TIME OF GRACE WHICH THE LORD GIVES TO EACH ONE OF US, I WOULD LIKE TO ADDRESS GOD'S PEOPLE, THE VARIOUS NATIONS, HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT, THE LEADERS OF THE DIFFERENT RELIGIONS AND CIVIL SOCIETY, AND ALL THE MEN AND WOMEN OF OUR TIME, IN ORDER TO OFFER MY FERVENT GOOD WISHES FOR PEACE.

SACRED SCRIPTURE ATTESTS THAT GOD BESTOWED HIS SPIRIT UPON HUMAN BEINGS SO THAT THEY MIGHT HAVE "SKILL AND UNDERSTANDING AND KNOWLEDGE IN EVERY CRAFT" (Ex 35:31). HUMAN INTELLIGENCE IS AN EXPRESSION OF THE DIGNITY WITH WHICH WE HAVE BEEN ENDOWED BY THE Creator, who made us in his own image and likeness (cf. Gen 1:26), and enabled us to RESPOND CONSCIOUSLY AND FREELY TO HIS LOVE. IN A PARTICULAR WAY, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY MANIFEST THIS FUNDAMENTALLY RELATIONAL QUALITY OF HUMAN INTELLIGENCE: THEY ARE BRILLIANT PRODUCTS OF ITS CREATIVE POTENTIAL. (...)

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE, THEN, OUGHT TO BE UNDERSTOOD AS A GALAXY OF DIFFERENT REALITIES. WE CANNOT PRESUME A PRIORI THAT ITS DEVELOPMENT WILL MAKE A BENEFICIAL CONTRIBUTION TO THE FU-TURE OF HUMANITY AND TO PEACE AMONG PEOPLES. THAT POSITIVE OUTCOME WILL ONLY BE ACHIEVED IF WE SHOW OURSELVES CAPABLE OF ACTING RESPONSIBLY AND RESPECT SUCH FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN VAL-UES AS "INCLUSION, TRANSPARENCY, SECURITY, EQUITY, PRIVACY AND RELIABILITY".
