# Kevin writes...

## SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

On this Second Sunday of Advent, we meet the rather unconventional figure of St John the Baptist. He brings a message that the Christ (In Hebrew: 'The Messiah') is coming. John the Baptist is echoing the words of the prophet Isaiah in our first reading - "Comfort My People, Console them ... Here is the Lord, Coming with Power ...". Maybe, we can ask ourselves this week if the coming of Christ really 'comforts' us! Certainly, for Christians, Jesus Christ is saviour and redeemer - but he is also - our friend and our brother! In other words, he can be very, very close to us - as a brother, as member of our family and our closest friend! As we prepare to gaze with adoration at the child in the manger - may we always remember that the God of the Universe has come into this world, born of Mary, because he loves each of us totally and personally!

- \*THE OPENING PRAYER ASKS GOD OUR FATHER TO PREVENT ANY: "... EARTHLY UNDERTAKING HINDER THOSE WHO SET OUT IN HASTE TO MEET YOUR SON ..."
- \* Our first reading is from the prophet Isaiah. The prophet, speaking to a people who have suffered decades of bitter exile, that hope and salvation are coming: "... the glory of the Lord shall be revealed and all mankind shall see it ...".
- \* The second reading is from the second letter of St Peter. The Apostle tells his newly baptised readers that while they await the return of the Lord, they are to do their best: "... To Live Lives without spot of Stain, so that he will find you at peace ..."
- \* THIS WEEK WE HEAR THE OPENING WORDS OF ST MARK'S GOSPEL: "THE BEGINNING OF THE GOOD NEWS ABOUT JESUS CHRIST, THE SON OF GOD ...". THEN QUOTING THE OLD TESTAMENT PROPHET ISAIAH, THE GOSPEL WRITER TELLS US "... SO IT WAS THAT JOHN THE BAPTIST APPEARED IN THE WILDERNESS "

POPULUS SION, ECCE DOMINUS VENIET ... O PEOPLE OF SION, BEHOLD THE LORD WILL COME ...
