FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

THE CHURCH'S SEASON OF ADVENT IS VERY MUCH MORE THAN SIMPLY 'A RUN UP TO CHRISTMAS DAY'! FOR THOSE WITH FAITH, ADVENT HAS A TWO-FOLD SIGNIFICANCE. ON THE ONE HAND, IT IS A TIME TO REFLECT ON THESE WORDS OF THE CREED: 'HE [CHRIST] WILL COME AGAIN IN GLORY TO JUDGE THE LIVING AND THE DEAD AND HIS KINGDOM WILL HAVE NO END'. ADVENT, THEREFORE, IS INTENDED TO HELP US REMEMBER THIS TRUTH - THAT OUR SAVIOUR WILL COME AGAIN TO DESTROY DEATH AND EVIL FOREVER. ON THE OTHER HAND, ADVENT IS INTENDED TO HELP US PREPARE SPIRITUALLY FOR THE BIRTH OF OUR SAVIOUR - SO THAT, WITH SINS FORGIVEN, WE MAY MARVEL WITH JOY AND THANKSGIVING THAT EACH OF US IS LOVED SO MUCH BY GOD, THAT HE ENTERS THIS WORLD AS THE CHILD OF BETHLEHEM, TO DIE ON THE CROSS AND RISE AGAIN FOR OUR SALVATION.

- * OUR OPENING PRAYER ASKS GOD OUR FATHER TO GIVE US: "... THE RE-SOLVE TO RUN FORTH TO MEET YOUR CHRIST WITH RIGHTEOUS DEEDS AT HIS COMING ..."
- * THE FIRST READING IS FROM THE PROPHET ISAIAH. THE PROPHET GRIEVES FOR THE EVILS OF THE WORLD AND LONGS FOR GOD TO COME AND REDEEM US: "... OH, THAT YOU WOULD TEAR THE HEAVENS OPEN AND COME DOWN ...".
- * OUR SECOND READING IS FROM ST PAUL'S FIRST LETTER TO THE CORINTHI-ANS. THE APOSTLE GIVES THANKS THAT HIS READERS ARE: "... WAITING FOR OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST TO BE REVEALED ..."
- * Our Gospel readings for this new liturgical year will be from St Mark. This week he gives us these words of Jesus to his disciples: "... be on your guard, stay awake, because you never know when the time will come ... and what I say to you, I say to all: Stay awake! ..."
