Thought for the Week

This weekend sees the start of the annual Season of Creation which runs from 1 September to 4 October; the Solemnity in Ascot of the church's patron, St Francis of Assisi. The theme for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation on 1 September is 'Hope and Act with Creation'. In the second reading, from St James, the writer speaks of us as 'a sort of first fruits' of all God had created. This gives us a great responsibility, for as the first fruits of God's creation we must respect all aspects of the creation from which we came and without which we cannot live.

Our first reading, and particularly our Gospel, stress the overwhelming importance of God's laws and the need to respect them, and not replace them with - for example - man-made rules about what is eaten or drunk. It is for this reason that Jesus upbraids the scribes who are more concerned about what goes into a person rather than what comes out. By doing so, they, and we, ignore the dangers for ourselves, for others and, by extension, to God's creation, by our words and actions.

Because we believe that God's Spirit is dwelling in us, whatever comes out of us which originates or is inspired by the Word of God, living in our hearts, is a service of God. St James gives the example that true unspoilt religion is coming to the help of widows and orphans when they need it – i.e. having compassion and love, looking after the most vulnerable in society; this must surely include the fragile planet on which we depend. By acting with creation we give hope to all.
